The Lee & Lois Herndon Chapter of TOS just completed two CBCs in Northeast Tennessee. The results follow:

The 78th consecutive Elizabethton CBC was held on Saturday, Dec 19, with 26 observers in 9-10 parties. Although the day started cold at 19 degrees, it warmed up in the mid-day. We tallied 77 species (plus 1 in count week), which is above the recent 30-year average of 73 species. The all-time high on this count was 85 species found in 2017.

The 68th Roan Mountain CBC was held on Sunday, Dec. 20, with 7 observers in 3 parties. There was 1-2 inches of snow above 4000 ft elevation. We tallied 49 species (plus 1 in count week), which also is slightly above the recent 30-year average of 46 species. The all-time high on this count was 55 species in 1987. This count circle is entirely above 2800 ft elevation with less water areas and open country resulting in lower over-all bird diversity and density.
