

## Results of the August Herndon Field Trip to Jacob's Nature Park

October 19, 2024

A total of 10 birders participated in the Lee and Lois Herndon Chapter of the Tennessee Ornithological Society field trip to Jacob's Nature Park in Johnson City, Tennessee on October 19, 2024. The day was sunny with a light breeze and temperatures ranging from 38-52 degrees. We met at the Ocala Street Entrance at 8:30am and birded until approximately 10:45am. A total of 26 species were observed including great looks at both kinglets, Winter wren, Magnolia and Bay-breasted Warblers. Here is the list of species submitted to Ebird.
