The 82nd consecutive Elizabethton spring count was held 3 May 2025 with 44 observers in 15 parties. We tallied 148 species, which is slightly below the recent 30 year average of 150 species.

Noteworthy sightings included Com. Merganser, Black-billed Cuckoo, Willow Flycatcher, Vesper Sparrow, Bobolink, Prothonotary and Cerulean warblers.
